Bookings

- Bookings are made via the STEM Zone website
- Full payment is required at the time of booking online
- Personal details are collected via the online booking form. These details are used in line with our privacy policy for contacting attendees and check-in at the event. Contact details will be added to our mailing list, which you can unsubscribe from at any time.
- STEM Zone reserves the right to cancel a session due to unforeseen circumstances. All participants will be contacted as soon as possible, and if rescheduling is not possible then a refund will be offered.
- If the participant cancels the booking, then due to hire charges, wages, preparation and material costs, your ticket is non-refundable. You MAY transfer your ticket to another revision workshop or to another student. Please email hello@stemzone.com.au with any workshop or name changes should you wish to pass on your ticket.
- STEM Zone takes no responsibility should you fail to attend an event you have booked for any reason (including illness). No refunds or credits will apply in this instance.
